Public Hearing for the proposed improvements to DD #14 at 12:00 P.M.

Jacob Hagen with Bolton & Menk, Inc., presented the report for improvements. Tiles are undersized and roughly 100 years old. Proposing to construct new tiles. They have broken the district into four parts to help with costs. They are wanting to put in new tiles South of Northwood to help with the watershed from town. This will be separate from the main. They are also wanting to put in a new system to the East and have it drain into DD No. 5 Open Ditch. This will downsize the tile size needed for the main. They will be separate from the main. The tiles South of the Quarry are the least important and only serve a small portion. A proposed route is still needed for tiles East of the Quarry. Public comment was heard. There were some concerns that one of the tiles north of Kuennen's may not be functioning properly. There are also concerns with the tiles that go thru Falk's and Trenhaile's. Discussion about crossing the Railroad was brought up. Discussion about one of the tiles North of 450th near the railroad not functioning properly. Bolton & Menk are going to inform City Hall about the proposed Annexation and tiles for Northwood. Report has not been filed yet. Classification and Annexation will need to be completed.
