

MEETING OF THE WORTH COUNTY CONFERENCE BOARD

The Worth County Conference Board met at the Courthouse, Magistrate Room, Northwood, Iowa, on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of this meeting was to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed budget for the fiscal year 2024-2025 for the Worth County Assessor’s office.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Stone at 6:01 p.m. There was a quorum as prescribed by law.
